Grandmaster Pointer have lived and trained in several countries and states doing his time in the armed forces. He attributes his success to his faith in God, the leadership of his Teacher Mr. Pak, while stationed in Korea in 1981 he had the opportunity to meet and train with Grandmaster Pak who taught him the art of Moo Duk Kwan, Mr. Pak became a father to me, as well as a friend. needed, the path of a warrior is sometime lonely, the road as a practitioner is long and hard few choose it even fewer reach its end.

Later doing his military career he had the honor to train under GM Edward Brown, GM Jessie Watkins, Grandmaster James Newton, Sifu Roger Miller, Grandmaster Gaudiosa Ruby and after he got out of the army he had the opportunity to train with Grandmaster Anthony Muhammad, Soke Lil' John Davis, Grandmaster Anton Muhammad in yearly seminars and Grandmaster Alvin Linzy in Shotokan Karate.
