Soke Joseph Miller

Born April 2, 1949, New York City

Retire USAF SSgt 1968 through 1988

Soke Joseph Miller started his training in the martial arts at age 7 with the YMCA judo in Spanish Harlem New York then went on to start his journey in Judo with John McGinley of Saint Vincent's Home for boys in Brooklyn New York Boerum Place while going to Chelsea Vocational High School on avenue of Americas in Manhattan New York. Soke Joe Miller Learned to Play Football and baseball there as well. Soke Joseph Miller started his sports career at Saint Agnes School Sparhill New York a Dominican order of nuns where his coach was John Glenn who played professional ball for the old Boston Braves. the following instructors of Soke Joseph Miller in Jujutsu were Dr. Saul Cohe Shihan, Soke Michael DePasquale SR. of the Yoshitsune Jujutsu system, and Shodai Yoshiji Okuyama AKA Okuyama Ryuho of the Hakkoryu Jujutsu System. Soke Joseph Miller attained the rank of Judan Shihan in Hakkoryu. Soke Joseph Miller was also recognized and awarded the California Board of Post-Secondary License to Teach Martial Arts and Shiatsu 2006 through 2009, achieved the Koho Shiatsu License by Okuyama Yoshiji Founder of Hakkoryu Koho Shiatsu Igaku. Also Achieved the Namikoshi Tokyo Shiatsu License. Soke Miller started his journey in Shiatsu 1972 Japan and has been studying and teaching ever since, 59 years total. Soke Miller started his martial arts at the age 13 years old. Soke Joe Miller started his form of Police Apprehension in the late 80's and it was approved as a field-testing stage for the Military Police at Yokota

Air Force Base. Soke Miller also started his own system of Shiatsu based on what he had achieved in Japan through other systems also in the late 80's had it copyrighted with the library of congress. He also Published with his copartner Allen Woodman a book on Shiatsu massage called The Healing Touch Complete which is now on sale with Amazon. He also wrote a book on Police Apprehension based on Military apprehension procedures which is also on sale with Amazon. Lastly, Soke Joseph Miller is the oldest surviving student Shodai Okuyama Yoshiji of the Hakkoryu system and all Japanese and foreigners throughout the world. He studied under Shodai Yoshiji Okuyama AKA Ryuho Okuyama from 1972 through 1985 before his death. He is also the first Black American and probably foreigner ever to achieve the rank Shihan and Judan Shihan 10th Degree in Hakkoryu Jujutsu.
